Enclosed is a hand-collated dummy for the Spine Section Annual Meeting Program.

As an additional consequence, note that the images are centered on the sheets. This will require some careful cutting, and the cut elements cannot be stacked, as you would normally do for perfect binding.

I am sorry about this complication, but it could not be avoided, without further delay.

There is no need to purchase stock for this small job. I further understand that she has called for burgundy ink, and we will leave the specific color to your discretion.
