Minutes of Spine Section Executive Committee Meeting March 15, 2006

#### Members Present:

#### **Guests:**

Secretary's report given by Dr. Resnick: Minutes approved

Dr. Wolfla moved that Dr. Gerszten be made chair of the awards committee. The motion was seconded and approved.

**Treasurer's report**: Dr. Wolfla reported that the section the net revenue for 2004-2005 was increased compared to previous years. As of 12/31/05 the sections net worth was approximately 1.8 million dollars, approximately \$100,000 more than the year previously. The long term investment report was reviewed.

**Annual Meeting**: Dr. Mclaughlin reported abstract and poster submissions, acceptances and withdrawals. Investigation into withdrawals revealed that we do not have a formal policy for dealing with late withdrawals.

Dr. Mclaughlin moved that if an oral presentation is withdrawn less than one month prior to the meeting, or the speaker fails to present without withdrawal, then that speaker would not be allowed to have a platform presentation at the annual meeting for two years.

Discussion included issues such as co-authors, family emergencies, penalty, mechanisms for enforcement, etc.

Multiple suggestions regarding the mechanics of the proposal were made. Further discussion was tabled.

Dr. McLaughlin was charged with developing the policy further and to report back to the EC in April.

Dr. McLaughlin then reported problems with meeting services with the AANS. The agreement that was worked out with the AANS regarding dedicated staff apparently has not been honored. Further discussion was tabled until later in the meeting.

Dr. Groff brought up the AANS policy of not allowing presentation of abstracts presented at the Spine Section. He noted that six speakers withdrew presentations because of the AANS policy. Dr. Alexander commented that the audiences may be different and it may not be as big a deal as we think. Dr. Wolfla thought that the AANS policy was fine, but did not think that the AANS should have access to our abstract database. Dr. Fessler reported that the policy has been in place for some time, but has only been actively

enforced recently. Substantial discussion ensued regarding whether or not multiple presentations to different audiences is legitimate or should be discouraged and whether or not there is anything we can or should do in this regard.

Dr. Groff moved that communication regarding conflicts with the individual presenters at the spine section should be vetted through the scientific program committee. This was tabled until the meeting services discussion.

**Exhibits**: Dr. Knightly presented the exhibits report (attached). Highlights included the fact that fewer exhibit spots were available than last year despite a last minute change to electronic poster format to free up more space and allow more posters to be presented. Why the space issue was an issue at all is not clear. Dr. Alexander questioned whether or not the original space requests were honored. Because of staff changes at the AANS, access to these documents has been limited.

Posters will be in a different room than the exhibits. Sponsorships were discussed (see attached). Overall, the section should be in the black by approximately \$40,000 with regard to budget. There will be a problem given the discrepancy in exhibit hall size between Orlando and Phoenix.

**Education:** John Hurlbert reported on the changes in the CNS format using interactive formats and the sections response to requests for content. Dr. Groff will be taking over for the next year.

**Future Sites:** Dr. Alexander reported that we are committed to sites for 2007, 2008, and 2009 (Desert Ridge and Buena Vista Palace). Dr. Kalfas will be taking over with the new meeting services providers to work on finding sites for future years.

**Nominations Committee:** Dr. Rodts reported that the slate of officers and members at large has been approved by the EC and by electronic vote by the membership. A formal announcement of the results will occur at the annual business meeting on Friday. The slate is: President elect: Joe Alexander, Treasurer: Chris Wolfla, Member at Large: Greg Trost.

**Fellowships:** Dr. Wolfla presented the report enclosed in the agenda book. There have been many problems related funding of the fellowships due to staff turnover at the Section EC level, at the AANS, and at the sponsoring companies. Appropriate contracts/agreements with sponsoring companies have been secured with Medtronic, Integra, Depuy, Synthes. The Aesculap arrangement is still unclear. Documentation is provided in the agenda book. Dr. Wolfla was thanked by the committee for his work in straightening out and clarifying the multiple fellowships.

Two suggestions were made to clarify the process:

- 1) Letter from institution or chairman guaranteeing support of project
- 2) Requirement for presentation at subsequent section meetings

Dr. Gerszten will be taking over the committee leadership. Drs. Trost, Hurlbert, Kuntz, and Mummanneni volunteered to serve as fellowship reviewers. Dr. Levi will also be asked to participate.

**Website:** Dr. Wolfla encouraged the EC to peruse the website and to provide critique as necessary. A full report is attached in the agenda book.

Guidelines: no report given

**Outcomes:** Dr. Kaiser reported that the ABNS has approached his committee regarding "performance in practice" outcomes for the MOC process. The QIW/Section initiated lumbar stenosis outcomes project is ongoing with the participation of the outcomes committee. Dr. Gokoslan asked about the issue of stratifying infection rate reporting based on procedure as opposed to institutional averages. Dr. Choudhri volunteered to look into the issue as part of his role on the outcomes committee.

**Rules and Regs**: Dr. Kuntz was asked to revise the bylaws with regard to voting membership of the executive committee to make the bylaws more reflective of current reality. Dr. Kuntz will also look at incorporating electronic voting into the election process for officers.

#### **Washington Committee:**

See full report in agenda book.

Dr. Rodts reported that CMS issued an "intent of noncoverage" announcement for the Charite TDA. The comment period ended today. The Washington committee and the spine section representatives asked the CMS to delay such a decision until further information is available because of the precedent for TDA in all populations. NASS and the Section have collaborated on the comments to the CMS.

Dr. Fessler reported that this process is a direct result of cost cutting efforts by the CMS.

Dr. Heary reported that the main issue is to avoid discouraging the introduction of innovative products by withholding funding for unproven technologies.

**Action Item:** Reclassification of cages

Originally, cages were classified as Class III devices by the FDA. These are now being considered for re-classification as Class II. When BMP was used, the classification remained Class III. The section is being asked to write a letter to the chairman of the orthopedic devices committee (see page 249 of agenda book) explaining that cage classification changes should be independent of the classification of BMP.

Drs. Fessler and Rodts suggested that the letter be forwarded to the Washington committee for distribution to the parent organizations, NASS, and other interested bodies. *Dr. Branch has been charged with writing the letter*.

Informational items: Further decreases in CMS budget and redistribution to medical specialties will decrease reimbursements by approximately 4-6%. The P4P effort was discussed.

Finally, the spine section has offered to make a \$50,000 donation to the PAC.

Dr. Heary moved to make the donation to the PAC. The motion was seconded.

Discussion ensued about what the differences between the PAC, DMLR, and NHPCA are. Dr. Fessler stated that the PAC is purely Neurosurgery and administered by the Washington committee. It was felt that donation to the PAC had the biggest "bang for the buck" in terms of being able to give the Washington committee more freedom to pursue projects.

The motion passed. Dr. Wolfla will contact the AANS and CNS to work out the details.

#### **Peripheral Nerve Taskforce:**

Dr. Zager announced the initiation of the Kline lectureship at the AANS meeting beginning in 2007 funded by Integra.

The Kline fellowship has also been funded by Integra as previously reported by the fellowship chairman.

Two issues from the RUC regarding nerve repair techniques (vein repair, synthetic graft) have arisen. The task force is also initiating new codes for nerve transfers which are not currently described.

**Public Relations:** Dr. Choudhri circulated a report regarding the logo contest- he hopes to have submissions together by the CNS meeting in October. He wanted to announce the logo contest at this meeting.

**CPT:** No report given (coding update course is currently in process)

**Membership Committee:** Dr. Trost reported that the online application process is now up and running (last two months). This committee will transition to Dr. Gokoslan. A discussion of making resident to active membership more of a seamless transition ensued. Dr. Gokoslan also expressed a desire to publicize membership opportunities and benefits.

**Newsletter:** No report given. The newsletter chairman was not present. A decision was made to transition this job in order to improve communication with our membership. A recommendations for Mike Steinmetz and Joe Cheng were made.

**Scoliosis Research Society:** Dr. Ondra provided the SRS curriculum for deformity fellowship training.

**CME Liason:** Dr. Mendel will communicate with Dr. Ryken and the AANS to assume these responsibilities.

**Publications:** Mike Wang will communicate with Dr. Dickman and other committee members to define his task and develop new initiatives.

**QIW:** Dr. Resnick relayed the activities of the QIW committee regarding P4P, Guidelines, and the Lumbar Stenosis Outcomes Project.

**Meeting Services:** Dr. Branch summarized the issues regarding meeting management through the AANS. Documents are provided in the agenda book. The major issues have been rapid and repeated staff turnover, failure to organize the meeting in terms of late publication of the program book, poor communication regarding the registration process, and conflict of interests with the AANS meeting in April. The intent is to have meeting services be run by another vender while keeping membership services and financial services with the AANS.

Drs. Alexander, Heary, Resnick, Groff, McLaughlin, Rodts, Shaffrey, Wolfla, and others related specific issues encountered over the last few years. Most issues related to poor communication with the AANS due to a lack of continuity and experience at the AANS level and conflicts with the AANS meeting occurring within six or eight weeks.

Dr. Branch moved that the spine section change its annual meeting service vender.

The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Dr. Branch further moved that proposals from the CNS, Broadwater or other credible vendors be solicited based upon previous institutional experience. Proposals will need to be reviewed and approved by the April EC meeting.

The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Dr. Branch moved that the spine section work to develop an infrastructure sufficient to perform the business of the section.

This motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

New Business: none

Announcements:

The Spine Section Executive committee meeting will occur at 1 pm on Monday of the AANS.

Dr. Shaffrey expressed the enthusiasm of J NSG to review manuscripts presented at the section meeting.

Dr. Branch expressed similar enthusiasm regarding The Spine Journal.

Drs. McLaughlin and Wang will assist in publicizing these opportunities.

#### Chris,

Barb tells me that you called yesterday about the generous spine section contribution to support our continued medical liability campaign. While we will be using AANSPAC funds raised from INDIVIDUAL neurosurgeons to help fund the political elements of our little quest, AANSPAC <u>cannot</u> receive contributions from corporations, nor can the spine section as a non-profit organization contribute to the AANSPAC. Your choices are twofold: (1) contribute to Neurosurgeons to Preserve Health Care Access (NPHCA), which can receive your donation – we are not making a big push for any more NPHCA contributions, but still can find useful ways to use your contribution and support the Doctors for Medical Liability Reform with this extra money; or (2) use the money to contribute directly to the Washington Committee. I know in the past the spine section has donated about \$25,000 per year to the WC, and not sure if you voted to do the same this year, but we have increased our WC budget to accommodate additional projects in the Quality Improvement area (e.g., spine outcomes pilot project, guidelines development, P4P, etc.), so a revenue offset to the WC would be great.

# Clinical Trials Committee Proposal

#### Problem:

There are many questions in spine surgery for which good-quality clinical trial evidence is not available, and too few investigator-initiated clinical trials in spine surgery; most current trials are industry sponsored. Most spine surgeons recognize that we need more class I evidence on many questions, but few neurosurgeons are trained in clinical trial methods or design. Compounding these problems, funding clinical trials is becoming an increasingly difficult challenge. Failure to correct these problems, however, will result in industry driving the field as opposed to spine surgeons, who should be in the saddle to push the field forward (with help from industrial partners as necessary).

# **Objectives:**

- 1) To encourage more investigator-initiated clinical trials in spine and develop strategies for team building and funding.
- 2) To increase appreciation and disseminate information on ongoing clinical trials.

### Background:

I have personally designed 2 multicenter clinical trials in spine surgery. The SLIP study is a multi-center prospective randomized clinical trial which tests whether adding fusion to a decompressive laminectomy improves outcomes for the surgical management of spinal stenosis with a grade I spondylolisthesis. Preliminary data for the trial has been published in *JNS* (*Spine*). We have 80 patients accrued to date from 5 centers. Grant support for this trial is \$250,000, of which \$185,000 has been disbursed to date. The second study, the CSM trial, is just getting off the ground. This study tests whether anterior or posterior approaches for decompression of cervical spondylotic myelopathy will provide better results. This study is funded to date at \$470,000. Preliminary results from the design process of the CSM trial have included a survey of the CSRS membership to define entry criteria for the trial; a manuscript on the analysis of the survey has been resubmitted after revision to *Spine*.

### Specific Goals:

# 1) To encourage more investigator-initiated clinical trials in spine and develop strategies for team building and funding.

- Provide guidelines on the section website for designing a clinical trial including NIH-guidelines
   (<a href="http://www.clinicaltrials.gov/ct/show/NCT00109213">http://www.clinicaltrials.gov/ct/show/NCT00109213</a> the SLIP study, for example, is registered with the NIH site)
- Keep an interactive forum on the website for potential investigators to join with those at other centers to create multi-center collaborative efforts. Provide useful information on the section website or as a newsletter to section members on funding mechanisms (such as the newly created NIH R34 mechanism) and resources for designing clinical trials (i.e. dates of American College of Surgeons Clinical Trials courses, relevant papers, books, etc).
- Work closely with the Outcomes Committee (Mike Kaiser, MD, Chairman where I am also a member) to help trialists to identify appropriate outcomes measures when designing their trials.

# 2) To increase appreciation and disseminate information on ongoing clinical trials

- To create a team award for the best clinical trial proposal that would by design involve at least 3 centers. This would be a great lesson in team building and we would reward all who collaborated (up to 5 people). I am certain I can create support for this from Foundations that support my work. I'd target \$ 750/ resident.
- To organize a time at the AANS, Congress, or spine section meeting for getting '2 minute updates' on current trials including those ongoing in Europe. The tumor section is doing this at the April AANS meeting and it allows investigators the opportunity to 'advertise' their trials in a national forum and gain recognition for being involved in long-term projects. In addition, we could have guest speakers address funding mechanisms for neurosurgical research. For example, the tumor section held a roundtable discussion with invited NIH speakers at the Congress '05 meeting regarding funding opportunities.
