



The Joint Committee on Education of the American Association of Neurological Surgeons and the Congress of Neurological Surgeons is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education to sponsor continuing medical education for physicians.

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Frank H. Mayfield, MD, the first recipient of the Harvey Cushing Medal by the American Association of Neurological Surgeons in 1977, was an internationally renowned neurosurgeon.

His training began at the Medical College of Virginia in Richmond. In 1937 Dr. Mayfield moved to Cincinnati to establish a community practice of neurological surgery. In 1973 the practice was named the Mayfield Neurological Institute in his honor.



Dr. Mayfield's achievements were numerous. His leadership and surgical skills provided a national, unified voice to a number of existing neurosurgical organizations. Some of his most notable achievements include the development of the model for aneurysm clips and other surgical instruments used world wide.

Other achievements include the development of the concept for corporate practice of medicine, as well as working with Ford Motor Company in the development of seat belts.

Dr. Mayfield has served on many boards and has been presented with numerous Distinguished Service Awards.

His talents as teacher and mentor have influenced neurosurgeons around the world. "He had a sense of excitement about life, about research, about opportunity and growth," says John Tew, Jr., MD, professor and chairman at the Department of Neurosurgery at University of Cincinnati College of Medicine. "He has been likened to Cincinnati's pioneering physician, Dr. Daniel Drake, because of his ability to assess situations, analyze and get people to come to concensus."

Dr. Mayfield said, "The ultimate goal of surgery is to make surgery unnecessary. The objective of surgery is to correct a problem that the human is confronted with within the realm of known technology. The idea is to study the changes in a patient so carefully that the surgeon can then hand that information to a basic scientist and say, 'See if you can find a way to achieve medically what we have achieved surgically."

He was the neurosurgeon's surgeon and the conscience of neurosurgery.
